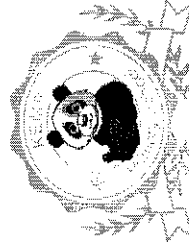

After careful analysis of data, Kemp Primary's Leadership Team will focus on our most critical deficits in the areas of Reading, Writing and Math. Students will increase by 3% in each content area. In an effort to reach these goals, Kemp Primary will utilize the following to collaboratively plan and deliver effective instruction:

- CCPS Framework for High Performance
- Evidence Based Writing
- High-Impact Practices/Strategies
- High-Order Questioning
- Academic Discussions

In the Classrooms

Kemp Primary teachers will work with students and their families to support students' success in reading, math and writing.

Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Send home weekly homework
- Teachers will provide decodable booklets and leveled text books to increase oral reading fluency and comprehension on a weekly basis (reading log).
- Offer family fun nights/curriculum nights twice a year concentrating on strategies that can be used at home to increase reading comprehension.
- Provide free subscriptions for web-based programs.
- Daily writing across the curriculum

At Home

Kemp Primary parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support student's success in Reading, math and writing. Families may offer additional ideas to this list.

- Parents will read a book to their child each day and ask them questions to assess their comprehension by using the comprehension questions. Have students to read leveled text on a weekly basis.
- Parents will attend Curriculum Night with their child.
- Parents will provide opportunities for their child to visit the public library each week and access the websites to assist with reading comprehension.
- Make sure students are utilizing websites and resources to increase math and reading achievement.

Kemp Primary Students

Kemp Primary students collaborated with staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed at school. Students thought of the following ideas to make connections between learning at home and school.

- Students will bring home books to reach each day and then read the book twice to understand the story.
- Remind my parents about Family Fun/Curriculum nights that will help me with Reading and Math.
- Students will bring home all flyers and notices about Family Fun/Curriculum Nights.
